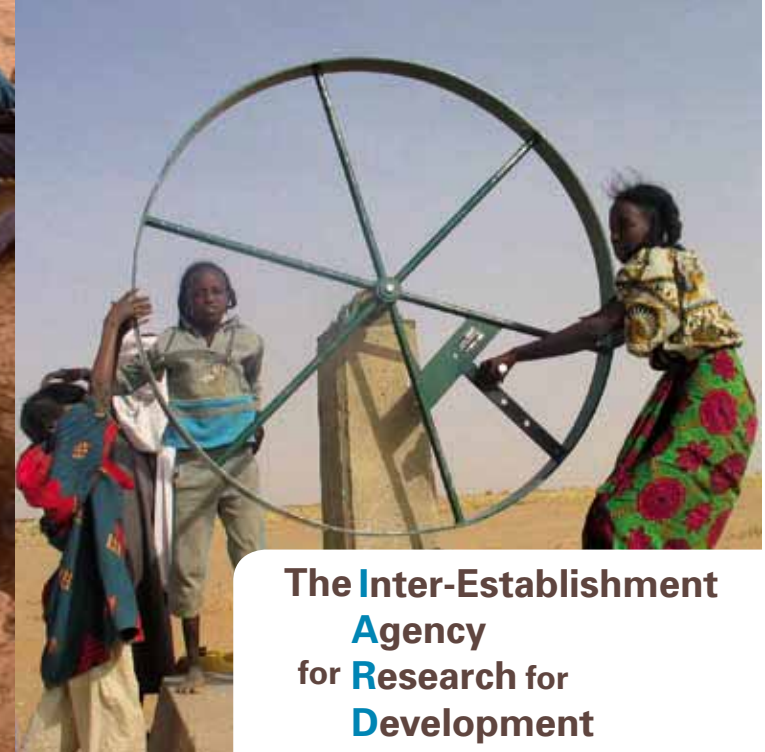

» Promote research for development

The Inter-Establishment Agency for Research for Development was founded in 2006 to intensify and coordinate the French policy concerning the development of Southern country through research.

It is tasked with amplifying French research efforts for development by:

- > mobilising the potential of the French research teams: universities (CPU), Cirad, CNRS, Inserm, Institut Pasteur, IRD
- > pooling various types of financing: French, European or international.



» A programming based on priority themes...

The agency's programming is based on calls for proposals open to the scientific community in North and South and connected with the priority themes defined by the steering committee among the relevant topics for research for development.

» ... and on the strengthening of Southern scientific communities

Strengthening and building up Southern scientific communities likely to produce the knowledge necessary for their development is a priority. The Agency intends to carry out scientific activities and develop related training including:

- > training through research
- > support for Southern research teams
- > regional research programmes
- > scientific supervision for regional technology platforms

The missions of the agency and its committee

- > Conduct continuous discussion of the concepts of research for development
- > Define relevant scientific topics for research for development
- > Define priority themes for the agency's programming
- > Identify, mobilise and combine the skills and resources of all potential partners, North and South
- > Issue calls for proposals and through these launch research-for-development programmes comprising a wider North-South scientific community
- > Evaluate the research programmes launched and managed by the Agency

The priority themes

- > Governance and public policy
- > Health
- > Nutrition and food security, agricultural and aquacultural products
- > Impact of climate change and societies adaptation:
 - population and sustainable development
 - sustainability of ecosystems, biodiversity and anthropisation
 - management of natural resources
- > Energy for the South: new and traditional forms of energy

These priority themes will be improved by the discussions conducted by the steering committee.
